

## CPC Indoor Worship Service Attendee Protocol

### • Attendee Mitigation

- Self-mitigation practices apply - Do not attend if:
  - You or living with someone who has COVID-19 symptoms: (Fever, cough, difficulty breathing, pain in chest, new loss of taste or smell, and congestion or runny nose, Flu symptoms, etc.)
    - Remain at home for 10 days
    - Fever of 100.0 or above
    - Other signs of illness
    - If you are in a high-risk category
- Attendees may stay in vehicles if they choose during service and listen on an FM transmission. (the frequency address will be published prior to service)
- Enter/exit only thru West Ramp and Northeast Narthex doors
- Your temperature will be checked. (Max. of 3 attempts)
  - Please remove any hats
  - Please move your hair aside, we need a clear forehead
  - Understand that we are not a medical facility and are doing our best to ensure a safe and healthy worship experience.
- Upon entering CPC you must record/present yourselves for attendance for contact tracing purposes.
- Attendee's may not enter CPC prior to 9:30am. Doors will not be open.
- Wash/sanitize hands before upon entering. Stations at Ramp Door entrance and in the Narthex.
- Social Distance Seating:
  - Usher will direct you to the pews (like a wedding)
    - Ushers will also exit you from the pews (like a wedding)
  - 6ft required between individuals/family group seating
  - Do not sit in closed/taped rows
  - Sanctuary seating does include balcony seating
    - If we reach capacity, attendee's must move to their vehicle
    - Or remain socially distant in the Narthex
- Tithe/Collection box available in the Narthex
- \*BYOCOM – Bring your own communion (when it's Communion Sunday)
  - You may pick up a pre-packaged supply in the Narthex upon entering
- Masks – Must be worn properly at all times.
  - Bring your mask
  - During social interaction with others on CPC grounds (outside)
- No passing of peace
- Bathrooms – Upstairs Only
  - Keep mask on
  - Sanitize/wash hands
  - Wipe down any handle/items you may have touched. Towels/Soap or wipes will be available in bathrooms.
- No other rooms are to be accessed unless authorized

### Self-reporting for contact tracing:

- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 after attending a service within past 3 weeks.

- If someone you've been in contact with has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 3 weeks
